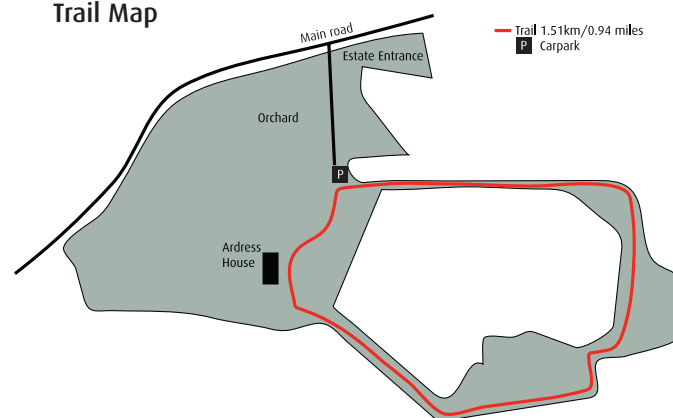

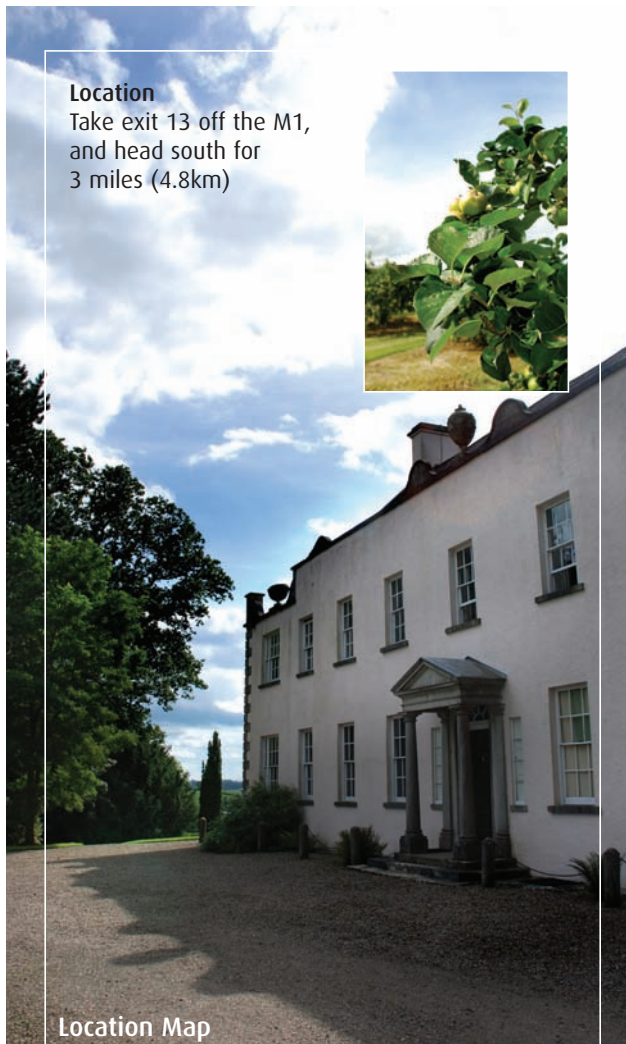


## Trail Map
