

Favour Royal Forest

Overview

Favour Royal Forest is known for its mixed conifer broad-leaved forest on the bank of the River Blackwater. You can see St. Patrick's Chair and a gigantic druid stone in neighbouring Altadavin, and a well that is credited with healing powers. This magnificent chair and well is carved from stone, reputedly built for St. Patrick on his journey through the Clogher Valley, and it has often been said to have mystical powers. Favour Royal Forest runs alongside Derrygorry in Co. Monaghan, which is managed by Coillte.
