






PEATLANDS PARK









Take a leisurely stroll or an energetic walk along one of 5 Waymarked Routes within the park. These routes have been colour coded and vary in length.

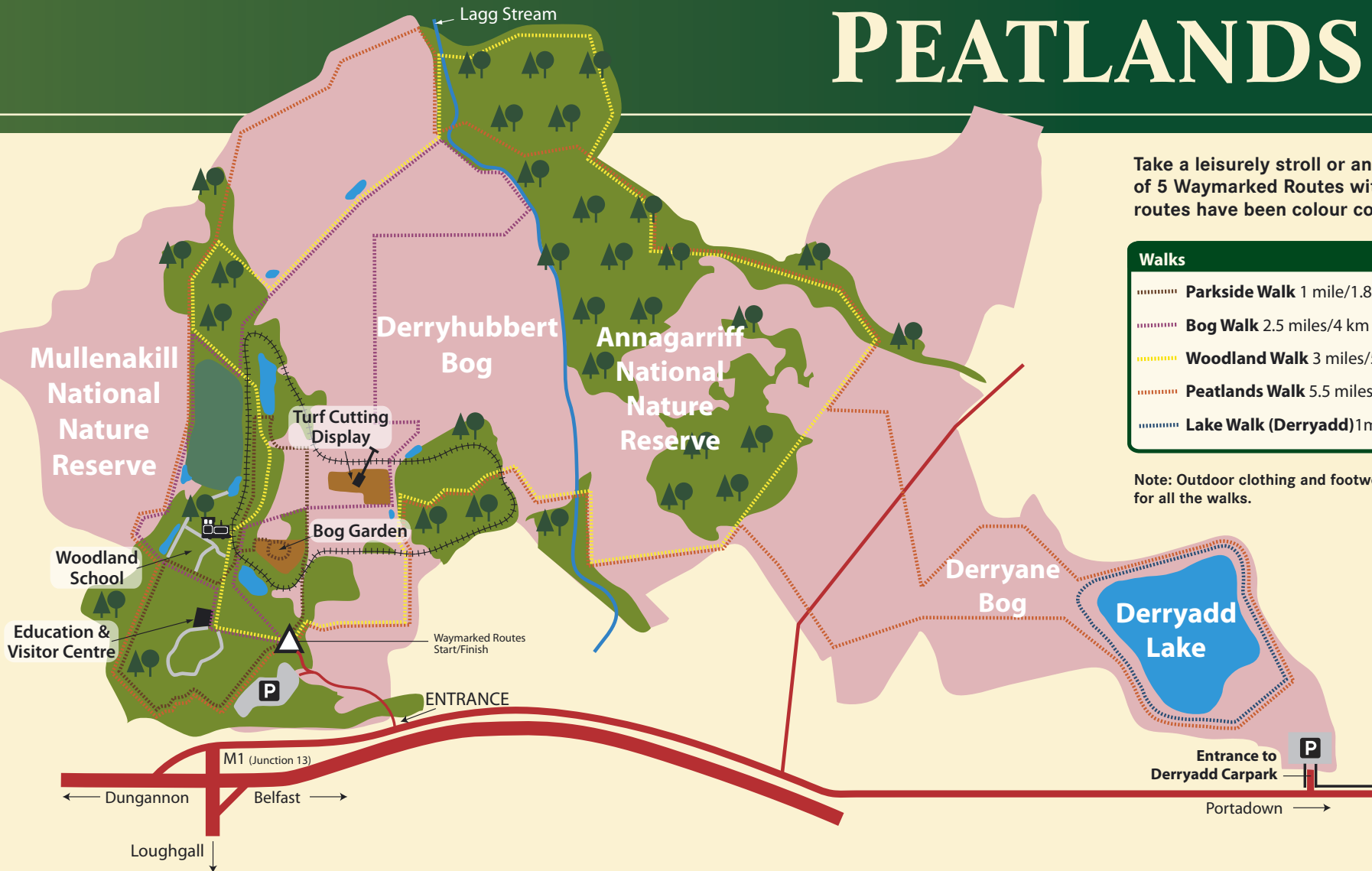
Walks

-  **Parkside Walk** 1 mile/1.8 km (approx 20 minutes)
-  **Bog Walk** 2.5 miles/4 km (approx 40 minutes)
-  **Woodland Walk** 3 miles/5.15 km (approx 60 minutes)
-  **Peatlands Walk** 5.5 miles/8.8 km (approx 90 minutes)
-  **Lake Walk (Derryadd)** 1 mile/1.6 km (approx 20 minutes)

Note: Outdoor clothing and footwear are recommended for all the walks.
